FBO / OPERATION REPORT – Dakota Suggs

In September we sold 20.2k gallons of Jet fuel, up from the previous month's 18k gallons. 18.8k gallons were through the fuel truck while the remaining 1.4k was through the Jet Self Serv. On the 100LL side we sold 7.3k gallons, up from last month's 6.7k gallons. 3.2k gallons were sold through the truck while the remaining 4.1k was sold through self-service.

Our Avgas self-service is fully operational and has had no further issues. The Differential pressure gauge is now fully operational. Our Jet Self Service farm has had an electrical short and I have contracted SE&M to track it down and replace the affected wires. The filters on all our trucks and farms have been changed and are functioning normally.

On the operations side of things, grass is caught up entirely. For most of the month the grounds were saturated with rainwater. I attended a class at Harnett regional that taught me the state standard for runway obstructions and helped me find the right vendor to purchase Taxi and Runway lights from.
